
St. Paul's Letter to the Romans 12:6-14

walk?' But that you may know that the Son of man has authority on earth to forgive sins" he then said to the paralytic -- "Rise, take up your bed and go home." And he rose and went home. When the crowds saw it, they were afraid, and they glorified God, who had given such authority to men.



IMPORTANT MESSAGES FROM FATHER MATTHEW

TODAY IS THE COMMEMORATION OF BELOVED SAINT PAISIOS who fell asleep in the Lord in 1994. Saint Paisios tells us, "Today the time has come for the sheep to be separated from the goats, the faithful from the faithless. Later we'll be tested and persecuted for our faith, and then you'll be able to tell the copper from the gold". Saint Paisios continues, "We must struggle with eager goodness to save ourselves so we won't sadden Christ. Christ will say to us, 'My child, I did so many things to save you. I poured out My blood and endured so much suffering. And you – what did you do for your salvation'?"

HOW TO ATTEND CHURCH "Be very careful", said Saint Nephon to a spiritual child, "when you are in church. There are countless angels above the people in church and these angels invisibly chant the hymns of the Divine Liturgy. But when one of the faithful begins to joke, to talk about worldly things, or to comment about others, the angels who see him, drop the hymn and weep bitterly for his plight, saying, 'Oh! Into what deep imprisonment this man's soul has fallen! How impiously, shamelessly and without the fear of God he stands in church! God bent His ear for him to fill it with humble and devout prayer and he fills it with laughter and criticisms'. And so, hearing these words, we should stand in church with more piety and remember the words of this saint. If we should forget ourselves and speak about worldly things during services, we should be afraid and ashamed before the angels of God".

The <u>FEASTDAY</u> of <u>PROPHET ELIAS</u> is one week away. Through great miracles, the holy Prophet Elias displayed the power and authority of God. How appropriate then, amidst our busy summer schedules, to take time out for prayerful reflection and beseech Prophet Elias for his intercession for our families, our parish, and our world. Orthros followed by Divine Liturgy will begin at 8:30am on Monday, July 20 and will be celebrated at Prophet Elias <u>only</u>.

Our <u>TUESDAY MORNING BIBLE STUDY</u> group has taken a summer break. We will be back toward the end of summer to continue our study of the book of Revelation. Until then, be well and safe and consider joining us when our Bible Study resumes!
